### Voluntary and School Contributions Charges 2019

Dear Parents

The Education Act 1999 requires schools to notify parents of all contributions and charges prior to the start of the school year. These costs are divided into four areas: Voluntary School Contributions, Charges, Personal Use Items and Extra Cost Options that have been endorsed by the Success School Board.

1. **Voluntary School Contributions** - A voluntary school contribution towards the cost of items used in the educational program provided for your child.
2. **Charges** for extra cost optional items - these are estimated amount for non-compulsory activities, which require payment as a condition of participation by students.
3. **Personal Use Items** required for use in the educational program eg stationery items.
4. **Extra Cost Options** available to students if families wish to participate.

#### 1. Voluntary School Contributions (Kindergarten to Year 6)

The total amount of Voluntary School Contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay is **\$60.00 per student**. This equates to approximately \$1.50 per week. While Contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family contributes to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. **As an incentive, parents will receive a 10% discount (\$54.00) if the contribution is paid before the end of Term 1.** The contribution will be used toward supporting programs in a number of learning areas.

These funds collected will be used to supplement expenditure in any of the following areas:

- Library – books/resources
- Literacy resources (e.g. supplementary reading books)
- Mathematics and Science resources
- Physical Education resources
- Information Technology resources
- Performing and Visual Arts materials

#### 2. Charges

This amount can vary from year to year and from class to class. A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in excursions/in-school activities etc for 2019 has been outlined in the schedule below. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the **maximum** charged for scheduled activities in 2019. **Students can only participate if they have parental permission and have paid the charge.** This amount would cover the following activities: *Visiting performers, in-school activities, excursions, interschool sport, etc.*

The above payment can be made upfront at the beginning of the year <u>or</u> through the West School Supplies Personal Use Items List. From time to time the estimated charges are not spent fully. If parents have chosen the option to pay these charges upfront an automatic roll over within RM billing will occur and these funds will remain in the individual student account. If paying charges upfront parents are encouraged to contact the school for an account balance before paying the charges for the following year.

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**Payment of Voluntary School Contributions and Activity Charges** - (see schedule above) can be paid at the commencement of the school year. Payment can be paid at the school office by cash, cheque (payable to Success Primary School), in 2019. EFTPOS/Credit Card facilities are available for payments **over \$20**. Other amounts listed need to be **paid to the class teacher/front office** as they arise throughout the school year. Parents will be notified of these events via an activity note, the school website or in the school newsletter.

#### 3. Personal Use Items.

The cost for these items will vary from student to student. This list covers items of a personal nature, eg pens/pencils/scrapbooks, etc. Parents may purchase these items from their chosen retailer or use the nominated school supplier **West School Supplies**. The school receives a small commission from the supplier for each order received. If you wish your order to be processed by **West School Supplies**, please complete the Personal Use Items List. Please delete any items retained from the previous year (marked R).
